A quick overview of the programme:

The core of the InFo-TED Academy programme is an intensive summer school, from the 9th till 14th of June 2025. The HAN University of applied Sciences and the Radboud University in Nijmegen in the Netherlands will host the Academy.

You can share experiences and gain new insights with colleagues from different European countries. Prior to the summer school, there will be three online webinars (10-12-2014, 4-3-2025, 15-4-2025). In the autumn (Oct-Dec) of 2025, there will be a wrap up. The wrap up consists also of three online webinars.

The main focus is on professional development for teacher educators. During the InFo-TED academy, participants will work on concrete products and share them with teacher educators in their own working environment.

About the programme


The online webinars (spring & autumn), and summer school form a coherent curriculum and is made up of five main lines:

- L. Knowledge base line: Inspiring keynotes
- Inquiry-based collaboration line (peer group) :Collaboration on knowledge products
- 3. Exploration in other context / boundary crossing line: Getting to know another national context
- 4. Knowledge mobilization line: Sharing knowledge and expertise in an international setting
- 5. Reflection line: individual reflection

Topics include for the keynote speakers are, for example, "Teacher Educator Identity", "Teacher Educator Professional Development" and "Diversity and Inclusion". We've got some great speakers lined up, but things might change a bit as we get closer to the event. So far, we've got Amanda Berry (Australia), Paulien Meijer (Netherlands), Geert Kelchtermans (Belgium), Liz White (UK), Miranda Timmermans (Netherlands), and Marco Snoek (Netherlands).

The workshops are all about developing skills. For instance, there's a workshop on publishing your research as a teacher educator. Participants are also encouraged to deliver a workshop for the group.

During the working group sessions, facilitators will work on a biographical storyline and group work on products and/or self-selected output.
